Operational Tour :

Encourage and embrace work-based learning by welcoming students to your facility for an eye-opening company tour that showcases your business. Expose students to your culture and help them learn what your company is all about. Tours offer you, the employer, an opportunity to engage with students and share with them information about their company for future employment possibilities.

Job Shadowing

Job Shadowing allows students to spend 3 to 4 hours with a professional working in the student's career of interest. It is an exciting experience for both students and employers. Students spend part of the day in the workplace "shadowing" an employee, and learning what to expect in the "real world". Students engage in early career exploration that leads to better-informed career (and post-high school) choices.

Businesses might introduce/demonstrate the skills required for success on the job, show how teamwork plays an important role in the organization, have employees show students their areas of expertise, plan for the students to receive a tour of the company/facility, rotate through departments, work on a special project, sit-in during a group project or meeting and observe daily procedures.

Work Study Opportunities

Work Study programs are a type of vocational training program that encourages students to work in fields related to their major of study or career interest. Most positions require specific skills and/or supervisor recommendations. The offering should fit around the student's class schedule (studies always come first). Students engage in both classroom study and paid employment in a related field. Supporting a work study program can help a business identify and train talented high school or college students for full time employment once their course of study has completed.

Internship Opportunities

An internship is any carefully monitored work or service experience in which a student has intentional learning goals and reflects actively on what he/she is learning throughout the experience. Internships are an inexpensive recruiting tool and an opportunity to train potential future employees. The opportunity to evaluate prospective employees while they are working for the organization can reduce significant costs in finding new talent and assist you in finding the right employee to fit your company.
