Cake Decorating Contest Rules

- Contestants must be 15 years of age or older to participate.
- One cake per contestant, please. Bring your cake decorating supplies and equipment. Cake will be viewed for judging and the slices will be available to the public.
- You must arrive with your baked, UNDECORATED cake to Sussex County Day at the Sussex County Fairgrounds no later than 11:00 a.m. on Sunday, September 15, 2019. Bring your cake to the designated area (location will be marked with signage). Decorating space will be assigned upon arrival for anonymous judging. Cakes arriving after 11:00 a.m. will be disqualified.
- The Theme of the 2019 Cake Decorating Contest is: SUSSEX COUNTY
- Judging begins promptly at 3:00 p.m.
- A team of judges will individually judge the cakes using a scoring system. Cakes with the highest cumulative score in each category will win.
- Please do not enhance your presentation with toys or other non-edible objects.
- Judges will preview and score each cake and the remainder will be cut into slices and distributed to the public.
- Funds raised from the contest will support local scholarships (so everybody wins!).
- The Sussex County Chamber is not responsible for plates, cakes or anything submitted for judging, and will discard (or eat) any items left on the tables.
