

Quality in Business.....

Community Service Award

This award is given to an individual or organization who provides strong community outreach activities, which could include sponsoring and/or underwriting the cost of worthwhile community activities.

Entrepreneurial Success Award

Given to a business leader that has successfully created new and innovative products or services and has experienced outstanding growth due to creativity and innovative marketing.

David C. Herzenberg Award

This award represents a tribute to an organization or individual who makes significant contributions to the health and welfare of County residents through the provision of direct health care and/or human service activities.

Humanitarian Award

This award honors a company, organization or individual who extends a humanitarian effort that is clearly outside the normal scope of their business or professional life, contributing financial resources and/or extensive personal involvement to the effort.

Philanthropic Award

This award is given to an individual or business that generously and substantially contributes financial resources from business or

personal sources to one or more charitable or non-profit in Sussex County.

Quality in Business Award

This award is given in recognition of a business organization which began as a small enterprise and has either survived in its original form for many years or has grown larger as the result of fair customer practice and/or exceptional quality of service.

Tourism Award

This award is given to the organization or agency whose cultural, recreational, or entertainment programs and/or services are of such quality and reputation that they serve to attract tourists in and around Sussex County.

Young Business Leader of the Year Award

Presented to a young business leader in recognition of his/her business achievement and/or service to the community.

Wellness Award

This award is given to an individual or organization promoting a healthier Sussex County through programming and or activities outside the normal scope of business, significantly contributing to the health and wellness of our community.

Beautification Award

This award is given to an individual or organization that has enhanced the economic well being and quality of life in Sussex County by contributing to its beauty and maintenance

Chairman's Award

The Chairman's Award is reserved for an individual or organization which has made an exemplary and/or extraordinary contribution to the County in the past twelve months.

Customer Service Award

Presented to the business/organization that can best demonstrate that it has the customer at the heart of the business and deploys and manages its resources to most effectively meet the needs of its customer base.

Volunteer Award

This award is given to an individual who gives of him or herself and who is known for his/her personal dedication and contribution of quality time to one or more charitable organizations.

Quality In Living Award

This award recognizes a non-profit health, educational, social service, or recreational organization or agency whose activities produce broad personal benefits for large numbers of County residents, thereby contributing significantly to the quality of living in Sussex County.

Business Partnership Award

Given to an individual, business or organization that demonstrates a partnership approach with other stakeholder(s) as a major element in their achievement. A "partnership" is interpreted as a formal or informal cooperative program or agreement between business enterprises and organizations.

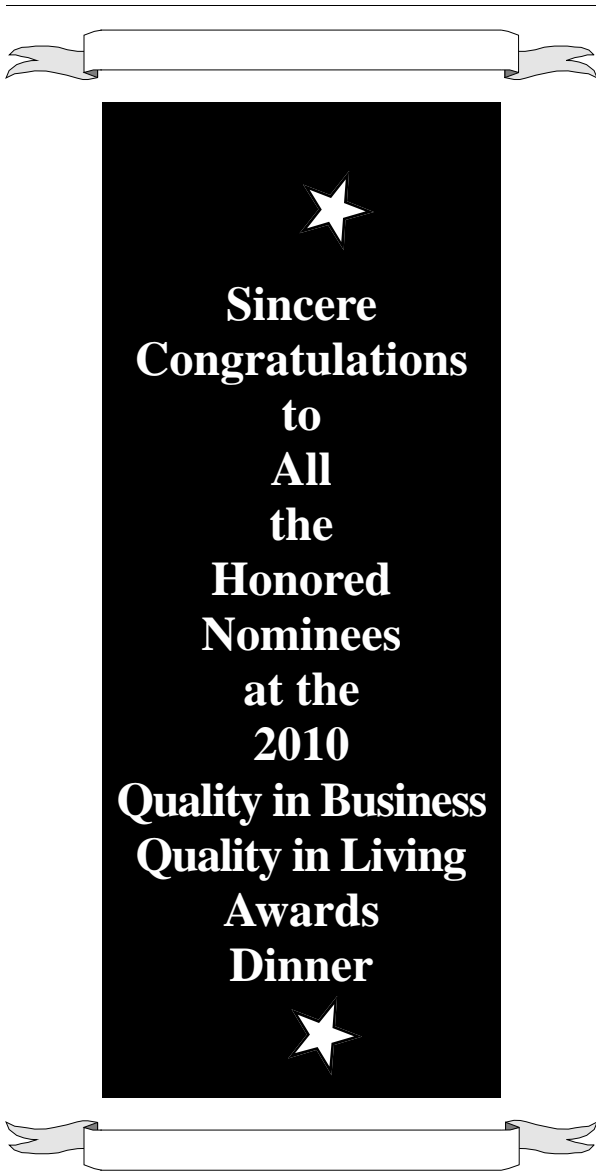

From humble beginnings as a tourism association, the Sussex County Chamber of Commerce has become a dynamic force in the area with a membership base close to 700 strong. The Chamber's growth trajectory is a tale of persistence, patience and responsiveness to the needs of the area's growing business community.

The Chamber hosts a number of networking events including the popular monthly Business-to-Business Breakfast, two annual Business Expos and the community-oriented Champion of the Grill festival at the Sussex County Fairgrounds. Over the years, the organization has often taken the lead in clarifying the impact of state legislation on area businesses including its opposition in the 1990's to the New Jersey Development & Redevelopment Plan and the Highlands Study. Long a proponent of economic growth and its promise of higher living standards and greater prosperity for individuals, the Sussex County Chamber was instrumental in the formation of the Sussex County Economic Development Partnership in 1997.

True to its tourism roots, the Chamber remains the lead organization in the county for promoting available tourism opportunities. In the last decade the Chamber established the first permanent Visitor Center in Olde Lafayette Village, branded the area with the "Sussex Skylands" moniker, garnered a Tourism Award for Excellence in Tourism from the New Jersey Division of Travel & Tourism and landed over \$100,000.00 in tourism grant funding to promote the region.
